To provide children and young adults with neurodiverse conditions, the opportunities and means to create better lives for themselves and their families.

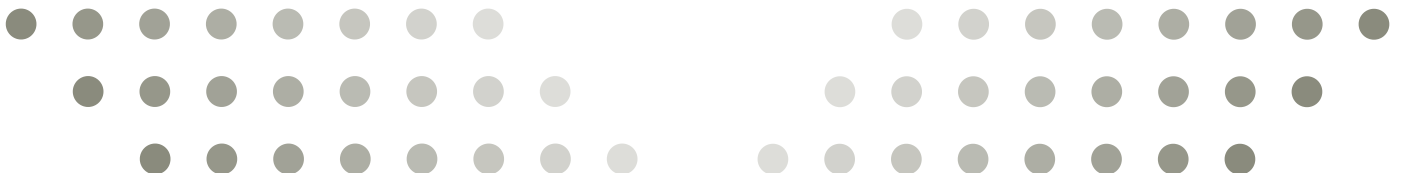

## Our New Vocational Training Center

The year is pronounced so highly because our physical premise got expanded and we came up with our new building of vocational training centre in the month of March. The new premise helped us to lay out each area of vocation, give a dedicated space for candle studio, chocolate house, digital literacy training, creative craft unit to spread their wings. We started new project of assembly work of electronics products in the month of September and Certification course in Retail Training has launched from this month onwards.

## Community Involvement

Our milap project started with the thought to support the families with special needs children from lower economic background, to support them with ration and hygiene kit. We have received so many friends, well-wishers, donors on the way who supported us and through them we were able to reach to 240 individuals. Vaccination drive was a collective initiative of Disability NGO Alliance and Akshadhaa Foundation, where we provided our premise and facilities to accommodate the persons with disabilities, their caregivers, frontline workers like therapists and special school teachers in the nearby community to make it easy for them to take the vaccine doses without hassle. Two vaccination camps were conducted and total 145 members got benefited.



## Blessings Gifting



The strive to take the sheltered workshop model of vocational training to the finer level where the hand crafted gift items will speak out of their own, stand high on their quality, packaging and creativity, Blessings Gifting brand was evolved with their new logo and social media marketing.

Only during the festival months, the unit produced more than two thousand candle products and wellness gift combos. Chocobliss chocolates, green potted gifting plants, paper bags, jewelry, coaster, aromatic diffusers were the added attractions. We were supported by friends, corporate houses with their gifting orders and encouraged us to come up with more designs and product varieties in the coming year.

## Volunteering & Internship

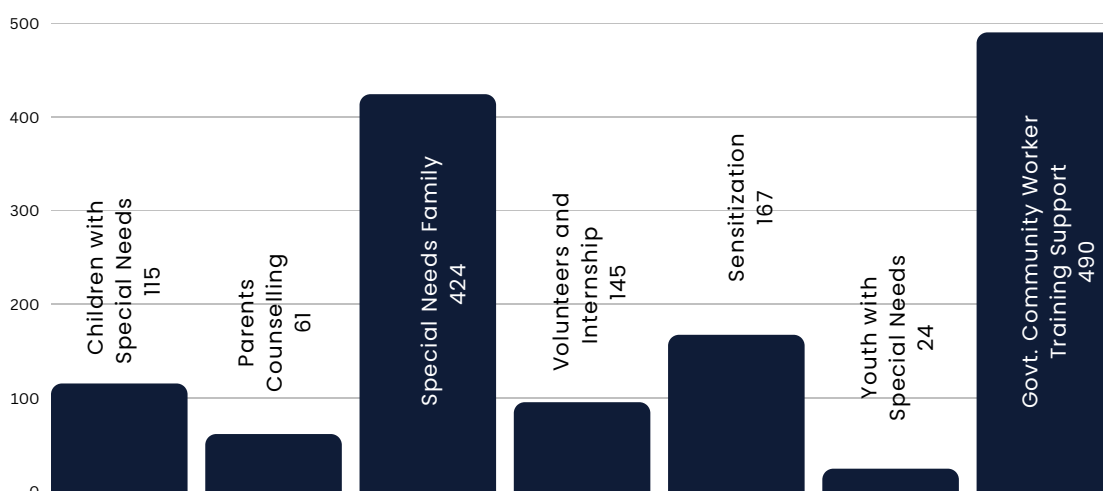

We are extremely thankful for all the support and care our well-wishers have shown to the Akshadhaa Family and what we have achieved together.

The screening camp helped the parent caregivers to understand the need of the hour and take right strategies at home. The child specific recommendations helped the educators to set clear goals and how to empower the mothers to work on improving the functionality of the child. The project also has supported Ashraya School to create simple teaching learning materials to build up cognition, speech, sensory integration and language domain for the children of age group 8 years to 22 years of children with autism, cerebral palsy and intellectual disability.

During this period Akshadhaa Foundation has done screening of 42 children and adolescent, sensitization and training of 10 trainers and 19 parents of Ashraya Special School.

# Akshadhaa Therapeutic Service and Education Program

Akshadhaa Foundation has extended the online therapy/teletherapy program from their 9 long years of extensive research and protocol based intervention services for the children with Autism Spectrum Disorder, Intellectual Disability and other neuro-developmental challenges. The vision of Akshadhaa Online Hub was to make the therapy accessible to the families and empower the parents and equip the home environment to have right kind of stimulation based on the need of the child.

The team of Special Educators, Life skill trainers, Physical therapists, counselors, Speech therapists, Arts based therapists did the initial assessment of the functioning of the child and created an effective home program. The training was extensive, hands-on and well explanatory. Parents also got the flexibility of having a trainer with the choice of multiple Indian language speaking abilities.

The training modules were focused on 09 different developmental domains of:



speech and communication



Social skill



Life skill



Gross motor-body movement-exercise-yoga,



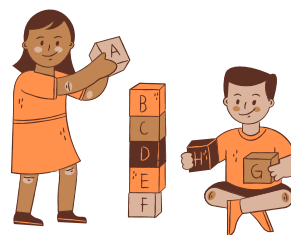
Fine motor-hand function-writing skill



Sensory integration



Cognition and comprehension



Play skill



Functional academics



The activities were simplified to suit the home environment to be carried out using home equipment. Each domain and purpose of each activity were explained to the parent by the respective therapist.

There was a periodical review and assessment of the progress with the parents and child through feedback form, questionnaire and video recording. New goals were set and shared with the parents based on the progress and evaluation of the existing learning goals.

Parents received ideas to create simple learning materials at home to work with the child. The learning program was supported with training videos, downloadable workbook, worksheets, digital learning video-presentations, quiz, games and touch and feel materials.



## Impact & Beneficiary Reach

The Online Therapy Program was the need of this Covid year and it supported 54 children throughout the year to receive individualised intervention program while being at home.

There were parents from different states like Kashmir, Jharkhand, Panjab, Karnataka and West Bengal who took support of Mother Child Program, Early Intervention program, Communication-Language & Play, Sensory Integration program



## LOVEFEST Celebration

LOVEFEST was the online platform thoughtfully curated for special needs children, adolescents and adults across India to participate, learn, advocate and enjoy together. In the month of April, which is also get celebrated as Autism awareness month, we organized an evening full of engagement with yoga, story time, fun games, visual art, magic show, rhythm, dance and movement for the children to explore, experience and enjoy with their family and friends. We had professionals from different fields who came forward voluntarily to take part and became resource facilitator for the event.

## Vocational Training & Supported Employment Program

Certificate course in Retail training started with the modules of In-store, Quick Service, E Commerce, Retail and IT modules. This course is connected directly with placement in Amazon for the position of Station Support Associate and Sale associate. Along with this, the vocational program expanded in the area of Eco friendly paper products making, Candle making, Chocolate making, Garden maintenance and back end cafeteria training.





## Stipend Generation for Vocational Trainees

9 Vocational trainees got stipend for their work engagement in the production department of Diwali gifting and Christmas gifts. The production and sale helped to generate the revenue which helped to maintain sustainability and the profit of the sale was given as stipend to these students.

**Total 15 thousand amount was distributed among 9 vocational trainees.**



## Counselling, Capacity Building and Awareness Program for Family Caregivers

Being a parent trust, it is the constant endeavour to empower the parents and family members with skills, learning and awareness so that they can work with the child with special needs and provide effective home environment. We conducted three batches of Mother Child program, sharing the hands on tools how to use the common resources and bring structured learning environment for the child.

A virtual panel discussion webinar was arranged in collaboration with NIMHANS, Victoria Hospital, State UDID coordinator and District Welfare officer to support the family caregivers to resolve the doubts and challenges with respect to UDID registration and disability card. The intention of this webinar is to bring the different stakeholders on one platform and listen to the experts who are leading the UDID project in Karnataka. Total 184 family members received inputs from the resource panellists.

Akshadhaa ran a month long OPEN FORUM for parents to address the challenges, sensory regulation issues etc of the children with autism spectrum where the senior therapists would provide guidelines and parents can ask questions to the therapists pertaining to their own child. 60 parents got the necessary guidance through this program.



## Sensitization, Capacity building and training program for teachers, community health workers and intervention therapists

Equip the Special Million is the outreach program of Akshadhaa Foundation which supported the grassroot level NGOs, community health centres to equip, empower and train their teachers, community workers and parent beneficiaries.

Two certificate program on Understanding Concept and Application of Sensory Integration for teaching professionals working with children with autism and intellectual challenges were conducted. There were psychologists, special educators and behavioural therapists along with pre-school teachers who attended the training.

ASHA works of Banaswadi ward, received sensitization session towards building awareness in Developmental delays,

identifying red flags, importance of bringing the families for further screening, immunization and malnutrition related developmental delays among the children.

The capacity building session with Amruthahalli hospital, Yalahanka Bangalore took place with 20 ASHA workers. These community health workers give visit to the households and families in the block. It is important that they know about the red flags of global developmental delay and the right help they can suggest to the parents.

Team of professionals visited Gulbarga and Bidar District where we supported two NGOs, Sevasangama and ORBIT with whom we worked in technical partnership for their beneficiaries. During this visit 61 children went through screening and early intervention social workers received recommendations, early screening tools and home management program from the therapists. We also helped them to connect with district level working bodies and hospitals and bringing funding support for cochlear implant, hearing aids, AFO brace etc.

We supported Ashreya Special School in Bangalore, provided training session for their special educators and done screening of physiotherapy need of the children at their school. We handed over the teaching learning materials specifically created to target cognitive skill, life skill and pre-vocational readiness.





## Community engagement & Corporate Volunteering

During Covid time when most of the engagements were happening virtually, the Akshadhaa team thought of celebrating International Friendship day little differently and including friends from different spheres of life. We invited corporate professionals, professionals from the field of counselling, college interns and children across the citing who are taking online therapy with us. It was two hours program with conversation, music, art and craft and fulfilled engagement.

A volunteering event was organised with our corporate partner ANZ where 50 + volunteers participated in this event. The volunteers had unique learning of "WHY" factors behind healthy practice for a healthy lifestyle from eminent Cardiologist. The interactive session with the children of Akshadhaa took all the attention where they were engaged in singing, talking and listening, sharing interests, hobbies with the volunteers. We were very happy to see the children inspite of their challenges in communication and language, were able to hold their interest, talking based on their ability and communicating by typing. Their smiling faces are the marker of the successful amalgamation of the human spirit, self-compassion, love and joy which was the objective of the event. We received lots of good wishes, blessings, good thoughts and reflections from the ANZ team at the end.

## University Students Engagement and Internship Program

Internship program is one of the strong pillars of Akshadhaa Foundation, where we collaborate, interact, network and open the door to students, young professionals to come and work for our special needs community.

The PG Diploma students of St. Xavier's College, Mumbai did their internship on Expressive Arts for children, their family caregivers and Akshadhaa Staff members. Arts based therapy is one of the less threatening, non-judgemental healing medium to encourage free self expression, feeling and perception. The sessions were designed based on the participating members, age and functional ability to try their hands with visual art, music, voice or story telling.

The Diploma in Counselling Psychology professionals from Banjara Academy did their internship with Akshadhaa Foundation. They got the opportunity to interact with the students, parents and

trainers of Akshadhaa to understand the mental health status and need of the community. This exposure helped them to gain confidence being a professional counsellor at the end of their course.

Masters in Social Work students of IGNOU did their virtual internship and training with Akshadhaa Foundation. They received learning about 21 neurodiverse conditions, Community based Rehabilitation, Early Intervention for children with developmental delay, Funding sources for NGOs and Family counselling.



## Showcase Day and Celebrations

### EVERYONE IS GOOD AT SOMETHING

This is the theme we hold close to our heart and work relentlessly with our children. This was the theme of our showcase day in August, where the sole purpose was to give visibility to each and every student and bring their strength, interest, likings in front of our guests, well-wishers, parents and give them the platform. We also showcased our alumni students who were successfully settled in open employment sector of packaging industry and hospitality sector and have become an earning member of their family.

Different cultural celebrations at the center is a ritual which we continue doing to bring an experiential learning of our culture and customs. We celebrated Holi, Onam, Christmas day and Dussera with ethnic decoration, language talk, making sweets and putting flower and colour rangoli. Children received gifts during these occasions.

Akshadhaa OPEN DAY is the celebration for the parents to explore the research based teaching methodologies and

vast creative hands on learning materials that we create in-house and use with our students at school and therapy unit. An array of TLM were displayed from all the developmental domains for different age groups. Parents of different schools, Special educators and Special school teachers also visited the Open Day to get more learning and understanding on the subject.

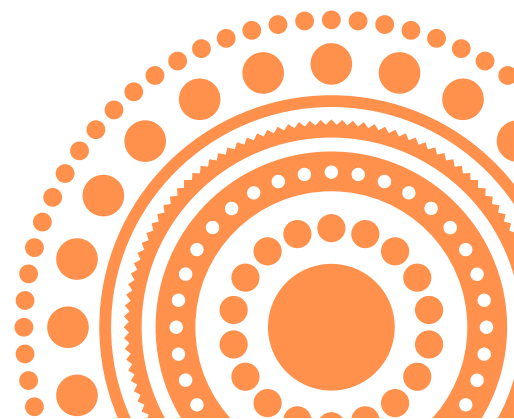
