Capacity Building

As a part of Equip the Special Million conducted Project, we one sensitization session for **ASHA** workers of Banaswadi ward. Building awareness towards Developmental identifying Delays, red importance of bringing the families for further screening, immunisation malnutrition related and developmental delays were the focus of this session. Session happened in Kannada, Tamil and English.

Community Outreach

A team of 4 professionals visited Gulbarga and Bidar District where we support two NGOs, Sevasangama and ORBIT with whom we work in partnership technical for their beneficiaries. During this visit we did screening of the children neuromotor issues, early intervention age group and capacity building session with the parents. In this phase total 61 children went through screening in two days, providing recommendations and setting the home training program. We also helped them to connect with district level working bodies and hospitals and bringing funding support for cochlear implant, hearing aids, AFO brace etc. Each family story is different. The inability to do more or to provide the right resources, lack of funds disturbs us from within. There is so much to do, and we feel so helpless at times. Sometimes the words of hope sound so hollow to self. The real grassroots level work understand that makes us disparity of working and being in the metro city.










Akshadhaa Assisted Living Community Project

volunteers participated in this event from the ANZ side.


The whole session was smooth from the beginning and had been appreciated by all the members.
