Equip the Special Million Project: Vathsalya Training

In June 2024, we achieved significant milestones under the "Equip the Special Million Project," supported by ANZ. We launched a comprehensive month-long training program in partnership with Vatsalya Trust, designed to strengthen early childhood development efforts. The training



program was conducted over four days and included six detailed sessions for 32 classroom teachers and community workers. The program was divided into two parts: two days focused on early intervention techniques and two days dedicated effective classroom management strategies. Our goal was to screening, improve early autism challenge common misconceptions and ensure that every child receives the support they need at the earliest stage. The program has been a crucial step in expanding our capabilities to identify and support children with autism, fostering a informed more and supportive community.
